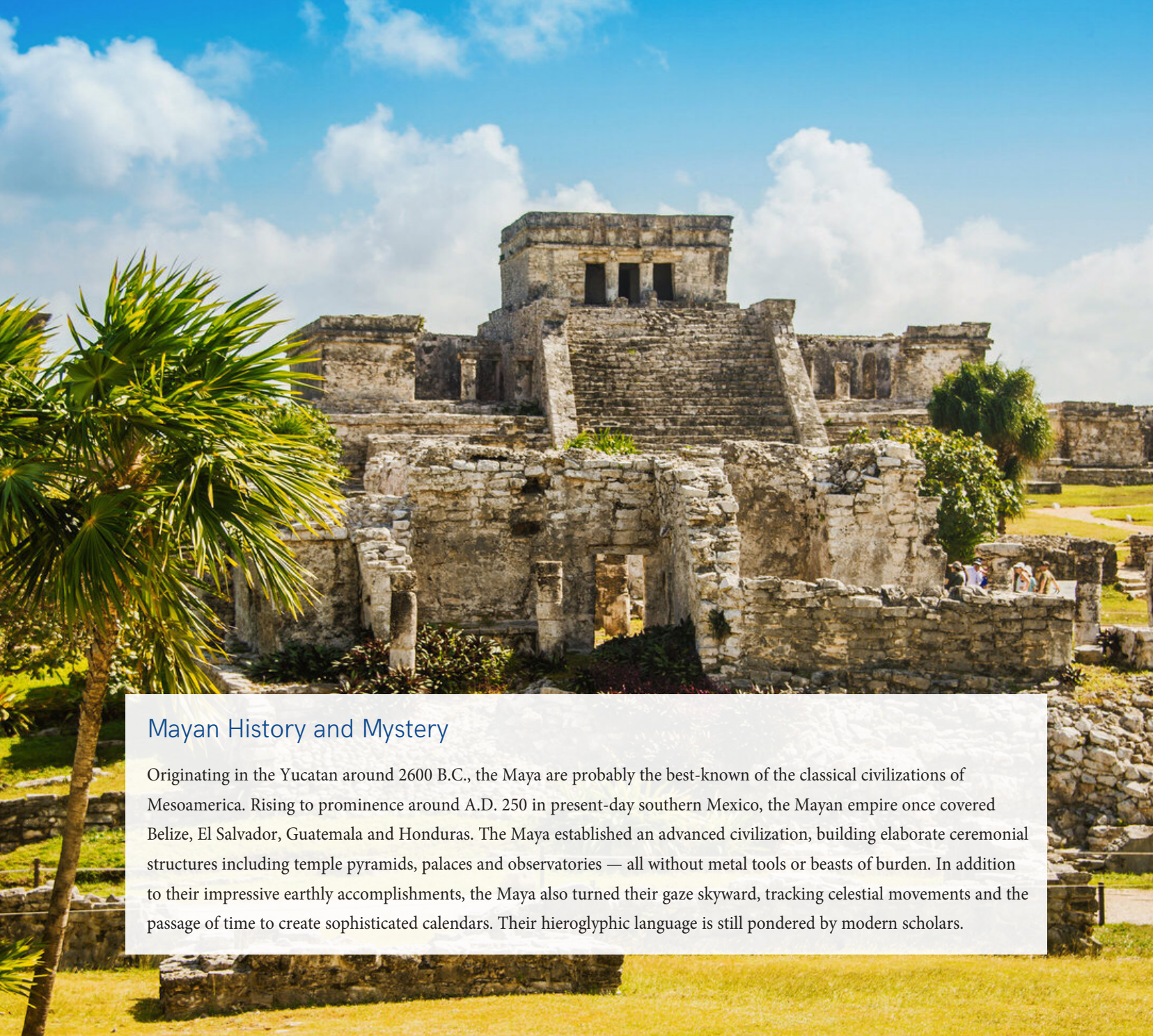

The Riviera Maya is comprised of the area west coast of the Yucatan Peninsula in Mexico. It stretches along 75 miles from Puerto Morelos, a seaside village south of Cancun to Punta Allen. It includes places like Playa del Carmen, Puerto Aventuras, Akumal and Tulum. Riviera Maya is one of the most fascinating destination spots in the world. Tropical beaches, ancient mayan ruins, abundant marine and wildlife abound. On the shoreline there are numerous golf courses, fishing and diving operations. The most popular travel destination in the Riviera Maya is Playa del Carmen which is where you get the ferry to go to Cozumel.







### Mayan History and Mystery

Originating in the Yucatan around 2600 B.C., the Maya are probably the best-known of the classical civilizations of Mesoamerica. Rising to prominence around A.D. 250 in present-day southern Mexico, the Mayan empire once covered Belize, El Salvador, Guatemala and Honduras. The Maya established an advanced civilization, building elaborate ceremonial structures including temple pyramids, palaces and observatories — all without metal tools or beasts of burden. In addition to their impressive earthly accomplishments, the Maya also turned their gaze skyward, tracking celestial movements and the passage of time to create sophisticated calendars. Their hieroglyphic language is still pondered by modern scholars.

### Fun Facts about Riviera Maya

- Riviera Maya spans about 80 miles of the Yucatan coastline connected by a single highway making it simple for travelers to navigate through the area.
- Riviera Maya’s beaches offer a wide variety of landscapes and activities suitable for all ages. Each beach has its own character and terrain, from thriving cities to remote and quiet beaches.
- The world’s second-largest coral reef, a.k.a. the Meso-American Reef, stretches across the Riviera Maya shores making it one of the top destinations among divers and snorkelers.
- No Plastic Bags. That’s right, Quintana Roo has a ban on single-use plastic bags so if you’re planning to do any grocery shopping be sure to bring reusable shopping bags. Of course, you can always purchase them at the counter too.
- Riviera Maya has over 435 miles of underwater caverns and almost 200 archeological sites sprinkled across the peninsula. It’s a great destination to explore ancient Maya Ruins, cenotes, and connect with nature.
- The white, soft and clean sand of the beaches in Riviera Maya is due to the crushed coral that is bountiful in the Yucatan Peninsula, creating the white sand beaches.
- Spanish settlers discovered Playa del Carmen in the 1500s and named the city in honor of Our Lady of Mount Carmel, the patron saint of Cancun. The name literally translates to “Carmen’s Beach”.
