DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

TO CLEAN AND POLISH: SHAKE WELL BEFORE USING. To clean and polish furniture and other surfaces, hold container upright and spray surface from about 8" (20 cm) away. Wipe immediately with soft, clean cloth. If the finish is very old, first try on an unnoticeable area to check results.

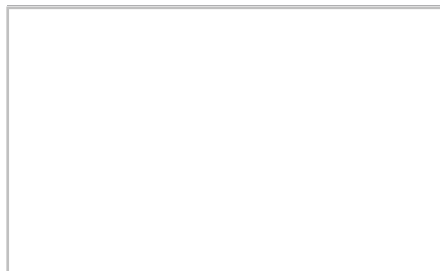
