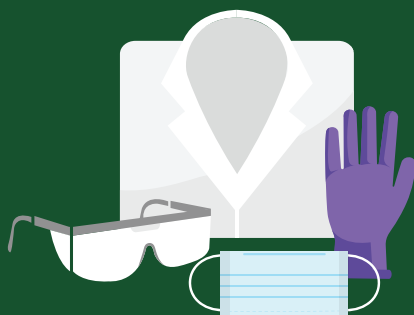
Approximately 3.4 million single-use face masks or face shields are now discarded daily.¹
